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
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PAJAMA JAM!

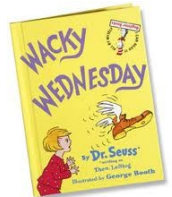

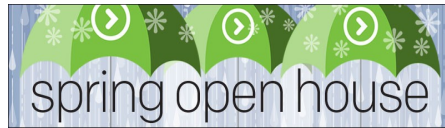


BEACH DAY

Developmental Profiles and Parent Teacher Conferences

All throughout the year, teachers are assessing your children for certain age appropriate developmental skills. We do this to make sure that we are preparing your child for the next step in their education. Teachers will be preparing Developmental Profiles and sending them home by the second week in March. We will then have Parent Teacher conferences to discuss your child's progress and answer any questions you may have. **All classes except for Miss Meghan & Miss Catherine's 3 year old class, will be having conferences on Friday 3/23. School will not be in session on this day, so that teachers can spend time with parents for conferences (This was on our 2017-2018 as a No School day). April 10th We will have a visit from The Harmonica Saints. The Harmonica Saints, which currently have about 12 members, are sponsored by the Nashua Senior Activity Center. In addition to harmonicas, the group includes vocalists, accordions, ukuleles, piano and a musical saw. The Harmonica Saints have visited the school several times and are quite the entertaining group. They get the children involved in singing and dancing and fun is had by all.

May 9 Animal Adventures will pay us a visit. You can visit their website which is www.animaladventures.net to see what they have to offer. We have had them visit before and the children love seeing and touching the animals. This is a short excerpt from their home page: "Animal Adventures is New England's largest, privately owned animal rescue center of its kind. We have been operating out of Bolton, MA since 1997. We started as an exotic animal rescue center and expanded into a family operated small zoo. Unlike the big zoos, we are not super fancy but do what we must to provide an enriched life for the animals. We take in hundreds of unwanted or unable to be cared for animals each year. Some, we are able to re-home and others will live here for the rest of their lives." This will be a special treat and all children are welcome. If your child does not usually come on Wednesdays, you are welcome to bring them in, but must stay with them during the presentation. It will take place at 9:30 and will last for one hour. A flyer will come home in late April regarding this presentation.
