Wow, what a great response we received from our families donating gift cards to the children at The Nashua Children's Home. We received over \$500.00 worth of




The CWG-WWS staff would like to extend a huge thank you to family members, who came in to help out with crafts and holiday activities during the month of December. Crafts were worked on together and help
